

New Year Eve Service, December 31, 2014 (Wednesday Night)

Peace and grace in the love of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Revelation chapter 2-3 refers to the seven sprinklings of blood in front of the Ark of the Covenant. It means the last sanctification that is done by God to the seven churches of the Gentiles so that they become as perfect as Jesus is or His bride.

It also means the suffering in the flesh together with Jesus we have to experience so that we are perfect or without blemish like Him and we become His bride who is ready to welcome His second coming on the glorious clouds.

Afterwards, we enter the Future Paradise and the eternal heavenly kingdom or New Jerusalem with God forever.

We are at the end of 2014 to welcome 2015. It means one year faster to welcome Jesus's second coming on the glorious clouds. Satan always tries to hinder us so that we cannot be perfect, but still have blemish until we are left when Jesus comes a second time on the glorious clouds. It means perdition together with the world.

We must face Satan with the steps of the sprinkling of blood or suffering in the flesh together with Jesus.

There are three efforts of Satan to hinder the churches in the last days so that they cannot be as perfect as Jesus is.

We must fight with the three steps in the sprinkling of blood as follows.

1. We face the temptation and force of Satan.

Revelation 2:2,4-5

2:2 "I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars;

2:4 "Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love.

2:5 "Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place" unless you repent.

God says "I have this against you" means there is blemish that will cause one being left when Jesus comes a second time.

The temptation and force of Satan happen through the sins, including the self truth up to the sin peak, namely sins concerning eating-drinking and marrying-being given in marriage.

The temptation and force of Satan cause us or the church of Ephesus to lose the love of God through the sacrifice of Christ. It means losing the redemption.

Consequently, one lives in the curse, weariness, heavy burden, and tears, and falls in a deep pit. It means being the same as the woman of Babylon that will be destroyed forever.

We must face the temptation and force of Satan by the steps in the sprinkling of blood, namely the first love or God's love through the sacrifice of Christ.

Exodus 13:13

13:13 "But every firstborn of a donkey you shall redeem with a lamb; and if you will not redeem it, then you shall break its neck. And all the firstborn of man among your sons you shall redeem.

How great a Gentile is, he will be the same as a donkey that is born only to die or perish forever (the neck is broken) if there is no redemption.

Therefore, the donkey must be redeemed by the blood of the lamb or the Gentiles must be redeemed by the blood of Jesus to get the eternal life.

John 19:31-34

19:31 Therefore, because it was the Preparation Day, that the bodies should not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away.

19:32 Then the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first and of the other who was crucified with Him.

19:33 But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs.

19:34 But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

Jesus has died with four wounds, so his legs are not broken. Nevertheless, the soldier of the Gentiles pierces His side and the blood and water come out of it. This fifth wound is the biggest and deepest one for redeeming the Gentiles from the sins up to the peak.

The sign of blood in Tabernacle refers to the Altar of Burnt offering or repentance. The step in the sprinkling of blood means the suffering in the flesh to repent or stop sinning and return to God.

The sign of water in Tabernacle refers to the Brazen Laver or water baptism. The right water baptism happens when one who has died to sin is buried in water together with Jesus and come out from water together with Him to get new life, namely heavenly one. Afterward, we have the Holy Spirit Baptism. The step in the sprinkling of blood is the suffering in the flesh to be baptized of water and Holy Spirit correctly or reborn of water and spirit. We have the new life, namely righteous one in faith. Living by faith means living by hearing the Word of God.

The results of living by faith are as follows.

- We have peace and quietness from heaven in the midst of waves and storm in the world. All things become easy and light.

Isaiah 32:17

32:17 The work of righteousness will be peace, And the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever.

- We are preserved and blessed by God up to our descendants and we can be blessings for others.

Psalms 37:25

37:25 I have been young, and now am old; Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, Nor his descendants begging bread.

We can give to others who need. This is the bright and clean fine linen or the garments of the bride.

Revelation 19:8

19:8 And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.

- We have the atmosphere of paradise.

Revelation 2:7

2:7 "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God."

As long as Adam and Eve heard the Word, they got the atmosphere of paradise. Soon after they saw the forbidden fruit, they fell in a deep pit. Let us live only by hearing the Word.

2. We face the synagogue of Satan and Satan himself.

Revelation 2:9-10

2:9 "I know your works, tribulation, and poverty (but you are rich); and I know the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan.

2:10 "Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

The synagogue of Satan refers to the lie, slander, and gossip.

Satan himself means the temptation in all aspects, tribulation, sorrow, prison, disaster or accident, persecution done by the antichrist, and the death.

Such things cause the servants of God to be unfaithful, even leave the service and ministry.

Matthew 25:26,30

25:26 "But his lord answered and said to him, "You wicked and lazy servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed.

25:30 "And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Consequently, they become the wicked and lazy servant who will be cast into the outer darkness in the hell forever.

We must face the synagogue of Satan and Satan himself with the steps in the sprinkling of blood so that we can be faithful until death or the end line. It means as follows.

- The suffering in the flesh to be **faithful in the shepherding.**

Genesis 49:11

49:11 *Binding his donkey to the vine, And his donkey's colt to the choice vine, He washed his garments in wine, And his clothes in the blood of grapes.*

The donkey must be tied to the True Vine. It means as follows.

- Faithfulness to the true teaching Word.
- Faithfulness in the shepherding pen. It refers to the Holy Place of Tabernacle with three kinds of equipment as follows.
 - a. Golden Candlestick or perseverance in doing General Service to have fellowship with Holy Spirit God in His gifts.
 - b. Table of Showbread or perseverance in doing Bible Study Service with Holy Communion to have fellowship with the Son of God in the true teaching Word and the sacrifice of Christ.
 - c. Golden Altar of Incense or perseverance in doing Prayer Service to have fellowship with Father God in His love.

Genesis 49:12

49:12 *His eyes are darker than wine, And his teeth whiter than milk.*

The results are as follows.

- We experience the sanctification in our heart from evil and unclean lusts.
- Our eyes are sanctified so that we have spiritual sight that prioritizes God and the true teaching Word.
- Our mouth is sanctified so that we can say correctly and do not stumble in word.

James 3:2

3:2 *For we all stumble in many things. If anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body.*

- Suffering in the flesh to be **faithful in the marriage and household.**

If a husband is sanctified, he will love his wife as his own body.

If a wife is sanctified, she will obey her husband.

If the children are sanctified, they will obey the parents. There will be love between the siblings.

As a result, there will be no betrayal, violence, rebellion, nor divorce in the marriage, even the house will be the mostly desired place.

- The suffering in the flesh to be **faithful in the service and ministry to God.**

Matthew 25:21

25:21 *"His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.'*

We do not want to even we cannot be hindered to serve and minister to God. We can serve and minister to Him well and the results are as follows.

- We are entrusted to do great thing, namely being used in the ministry for building the body of Christ at the latter rain, like a donkey where Jesus sat, to go to New Jerusalem or the city of light.
- We have the heavenly joy in the world until we get the eternal one in heaven forever.
- We receive the crown of life or the one of the bride. We have the eternal life.

Revelation 2:10

2:10 *"Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.*

3. We face the throne of Satan.

Revelation 2:13-15

2:13 *"I know your works, and where you dwell, where Satan's throne is. And you hold fast to My name, and did not deny My faith even in the days in which Antipas was My faithful martyr, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells.*

2:14 *"But I have a few things against you, because you have there those who hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality.*

2:15 *"Thus you also have those who hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.*

The throne of Satan refers to the false teachings. The teachings of Nicolaitans want to gather many people through all ways. The teachings of Balaam want to get much money in the service and ministry to God. The two teachings work together, namely gathering many people to get physical wage.

Revelation 2:20

2:20 *"Nevertheless I have a few things against you, because you allow that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and seduce My servants to commit sexual immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols.*

The teaching of Jezebel allows woman to teach and have authority over men.

1 Timothy 2:12-14

2:12 *And I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man, but to be in silence.*

2:13 *For Adam was formed first, then Eve.*

2:14 *And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived, fell into transgression.*

There are the teachings of Pharisees, Sadducees, and so on.

The false teachings will cause the false worship, namely to the antichrist.

We must face the throne of Satan with the steps in the sprinkling of blood, namely not denying the faith. It means the suffering in the flesh to keep on holding fast to and obeying the true teaching Word or worshiping Jesus as the King of all kings.

Revelation 4:3

4:3 *And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald.*

Ezekiel 1:28

1:28 *Like the appearance of a rainbow in a cloud on a rainy day, so was the appearance of the brightness all around it. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. So when I saw it, I fell on my face, and I heard a voice of One speaking.*

If we keep on holding fast to and obeying the true teaching Word as well as worshiping Him, we will be the throne of God where there is the rainbow of God's glory.

Genesis 9:13-15

9:13 *"I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth.*

9:14 *"It shall be, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the rainbow shall be seen in the cloud;*

9:15 *"and I will remember My covenant which is between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh; the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh.*

The functions of the rainbow of God's glory are as follows.

- The protection of God to us from the attack of Satan and all disasters or accidents.
- The miracle happens.

John 11:38-40

11:38 *Then Jesus, again groaning in Himself, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay against it.*

11:39 *Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of him who was dead, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there is a stench, for he has been dead four days."*

11:40 *Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?"*

The family in Bethany was let experience the sprinkling of blood through the death of Lazarus. As long as we live in righteousness and faithfulness, hold fast to and obey the Word, as well as worship Him, there is the rainbow of God's glory that will never be late. The physical miracles happen and so do the spiritual ones. All rottenness in our private life and marriage will be healed. Physical rottenness in economy, study, and health can be healed and helped by God.

Finally, we are changed to be as glorious as Jesus is and lifted up on the glorious clouds when He comes a second time.
